A limited number of field trips and excursions will be offered. These will require sign up in advance and will involve additional costs in order to participate. Some of these activities will involve travel to and accommodations on other islands. A minimum number of participants will be required for each trip. #### One-Day Field Trips Proposed to Take Place During the Week:

- FT1A: Coral Disease (1 day) - \$150 per person**  
Includes ground transportation from the Hawaii Convention Center, boat transportation, tour, and lunch. Involves some snorkeling activities; Hawaii Institute of Marine Biology.
- FT1B: Coral Ecology (1 day) - \$150 per person**  
Includes ground transportation from the Hawaii Convention Center, boat transportation, tour, and lunch. Involves some snorkeling activities; Hawaii Institute of Marine Biology, Kaneohe Bay.
- FT4: Oahu Marine Natural History Tour (1 day) - \$90 per person**  
Includes ground transportation to and from Hawaii Convention Center, snorkeling, tour, and lunch.
- FT5A: MPAs: Department of Land and Natural Resources (DNLNR) Oahu Marine Protected Area Tour (1 day) - \$115 per person**  
Includes ground transportation to and from Hawaii Convention Center, snorkeling, tour, and lunch. Waikiki, Waikiki Aquarium, Piko Lagoon, Hanauma Bay.
- FT6A: Coral Restoration: Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) Coral Nursery (1 day) - \$50 per person**  
Includes ground transportation to and from Hawaii Convention Center, tour, and lunch.
- FT6B: Coral Restoration: Kaneohe Bay Algae Control (1 day) - \$90 per person**  
Includes ground transportation to and from Hawaii Convention Center, boat transportation, tour, and lunch. Trip involves some snorkeling activities.
- FT7: Fossil Coral Reefs (1 day) - \$75 per person**  
Includes ground transportation to and from Hawaii Convention Center, snorkeling, tour, and lunch.
- FT8: Marine Laboratory Tour (1 day) - \$75 per person**  
Includes ground transportation to and from Hawaii Convention Center, snorkeling, tour, and lunch; features Hawaii Institute of Marine Biology (morning), Oceanic Institute (early afternoon) and Kewalo (afternoon).
- FT11: Aquatic Invasive Species: Alien Algae Control (1 day) - \$120 per person**  
Includes ground transportation from Hawaii, tour, and lunch. Involves some snorkeling activities (AFRC Urchin Nursery, Kaneohe Bay Patch Reefs).
- FT12: Manta Ray Viewing (1 day/TBD) - Price per person TBD**  
Sheraton Kona Resort & Manta Pacific Research Foundation (<http://www.mantapacific.org/>). Involves scuba diving.

#### Overnight Night Field Trips Proposed to Take Place Either Pre-Meeting or Post-Meeting:

- FT1C: Maui Coral Ecology (2 days) - \$600 per person**  
Includes ground transportation on Maui, boat transportation, Maui Ocean Center admission, tour, lodging, and meals. Involves some scuba and snorkeling activities (Maui Ocean Center, Molokini, and Turtle Town). Cost does not include round-trip airfare from Oahu.
- FT2A: Coral Reproduction: Maui Coral Spawning (3 days, 3 nights) - \$1600 per person**  
Includes ground and boat transportation on Maui, tour, lodging, and meals; Involves some snorkeling activities; Maui Ocean Center. Cost does not include round-trip airfare from Oahu.
- FT2B: Coral Reproduction: Oahu Coral Spawning (2 days, 3 nights) - \$500 per person**  
Includes ground transportation on Oahu from Hawaii Convention Center, tour, and some meals. Cost does not include lodging.
- FT2C: Coral Reproduction: HIMB Coral Spawning (2 days, 3 nights) - \$900 per person**  
Includes accommodations at Hawaii Institute of Marine Biology, tour, and meals. Involves some snorkeling activities.
- FT3: HIMB Coral Ecology (2 days, 2 nights) - \$800 per person**  
Includes ground transportation to and from Hawaii Convention Center, tour, accommodations at Hawaii Institute of Marine Biology, meals, activities, lectures and snorkeling. This field trip is being run by the Hawaii Institute of Marine Biology.
- FT5B: MPAs: Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) Maui Marine Protected Area Tour (2 day) - \$600 per person**  
Includes ground and boat transportation on Maui, tour, lodging, and meals. Involves some snorkeling activities. Does not include round-trip airfare from Oahu (Honolulu, Kahikili FMA, Molokini, Turtle Town, Ahihi Kinau, and Maui Ocean Center.)
- FT5C: MPAs: Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) Hawaii Island Marine Protected Area Tour (3 day) - \$900 per person**  
Includes ground transportation in Kona, tour, and lunch. Involves some snorkeling and scuba activities. Cost does not include round trip airfare from Oahu. (Lapakahi, Old Kona Airport, Kealahou, and Pu'u Honua O Hoonaunau)
- FT9A: Anchialine Ponds: Hawaii Island Anchialine Ponds (3 days / 2 nights) - \$1500 per person**  
Includes everything but inter-island airfare.
- FT9B: Anchialine Ponds: Maui Anchialine Ponds (3 days / 2 nights) - \$1200 per person**  
Includes everything but inter-island airfare; Involves some snorkeling activities.
- FT10A: Associated Marine Life: Maui Sea Turtle Ecology (3 days, 2 nights) - \$1500 per person**  
Includes ground and boat transportation on Maui, tour, lodging, and meals. Does not include round-trip airfare from Oahu. Involves some snorkeling activities. (Maui Ocean Center, Makena Beach, and Turtle Town.)
- FT10B: Associated Marine Life: Oahu Sea Bird Ecology (2 days) - \$800 per person**  
Includes ground transportation daily from Hawaii Convention Center, tour, and lunches. (Kaena Point, Makapuu, and Sea Life Park.)
- RFT1: A week of coral reef activities in Palau organized through the Palau International Coral Reef Center.**
